Doris Mock, age 86, of Ulen, Minnesota, died Thursday, July 12, 2007, in Viking Manor Nursing Home, Ulen.

Doris May Mock was born September 4, 1920, the daughter of George and Olive (Fowler) Spotswood near Cavalier, North Dakota. As a young child, Doris moved with her family to the Los Angeles, California area where she was raised. Doris graduated from Bonita High School in San Dimas, California, with the class of 1936.
