



Edwin "Fred" Frederick Sargent

Edwin "Fred" Sargent, age 55, of Mahnomen, MN, died Thursday, March 18, 2010 at his home.

Fred was born August 30, 1954 in White Earth, MN, the son of Melvin and Ozelda (Blair) Sargent. He grew up near Beaulieu, MN, and attended Mahnomen Public School.
