Frances Daniel, age 97, of Mahanomen, MN, passed away June 19, 2014, at the Mahanomen Health Center Nursing Home. Frances G. O'Rourke was born December 5, 1916, to William and Frances (Witt) O'Rourke at their home near Waubun, MN. She graduated from Waubun High School and later received her teaching certificate.
