Robert Beaulieu, age 72 of Mahanomen, MN, died Tuesday, March 20, 2012 at Mahanomen Health Center.

Robert Lee Beaulieu was born January 19, 1940 in White Earth, MN, the son of Roger and Jane (McDonald) Beaulieu. He grew up in the Beaulieu area and attended school in Mahanomen. In 1961, Bob entered the United States Army where he proudly served his country. Following an honorable discharge in 1968, he made his home in the Minneapolis, MN, area. While living in the metro, Bob worked for several years at Minnesota Bearing. In the early 2000's he returned to his parent's home place near Beaulieu. Bob worked in Maintenance at the Shooting Star Casino in Mahanomen until failing health last fall forced him to retire.

In his younger years, he was quite energetic playing softball, horseshoes and various other sports. Bob was a true outdoors enthusiast; hunting, fishing and spending time in the woods.
